



URGENT ROAD CLOSURE
3/169 MEYSEY HAMPTON TO THE NEW ROAD
(DOWN AMPNEY PARISH) COTSWOLD DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council has by this notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of 3/169 Meysey Hampton to The New Road from its junction with 400993 Road from Rooktree Farm to Wetstone Bridge to outside the entrance to the property known as Peasburge Barn for a distance of approximately 1200 metres.

The roads fall in Down Ampney Parish in the Cotswold District in the County of Gloucestershire.

The reason for the closure is to enable the removal of dangerous Ash trees.

This Notice comes into force between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00 on the 19th April 2021 only and can continue for up to 5 days. It is expected that the works will be complete on the 23rd April 2021. If the works to remedy the problem have not been completed within the 5 days it will be necessary to make an Order. This legal Order will authorise the closure of the Roads for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice.

Pedestrian access and emergency access will not be maintained due to equipment and trees being in the carriageway.
